As a pet owner, you know it is important to exercise your dog. Please take note the town provides an off-leash dog park. It is located at the north-east corner of town, 100 St. and 108 Ave. It is a huge fenced area, formerly a ball diamond, where dogs can run and play to their hearts' content.

The dog park is the right place to exercise your dog off-leash. School grounds, playgrounds and any other public areas, including Cummings Lake Trail, are the wrong places. (Leashed dogs are allowed on the trail)

In all cases, poop-scooping is a must. Carry plastic bags with you every time you walk your dog(s). Thank you for being a responsible pet owner.
