She says "After working a 10 to 12 hour day I arrive home to find my driveway clean - done by Darryl. He also does a few other neighbors' driveways....Darryl and Iris keep their yard neat and clean with beautiful flowers...Everything listed on your "What Makes a Good Neighbor" - Darryl and Iris fit. **Hazel Keddie**, nominated by Opal Chalmers was out of town - her award will be presented in June. **Neil and Darlene Krahn** were nominated by Lil Zaleschuk and Irene Stelmaschuk

"because for the past two years they have been wonderful in looking out for my Mother. Two years ago she fell and destroyed her shoulder and now is unable to mow her own lawn or shovel snow. Neil and Darlene both show up to mow her lawn and Neil clears her driveway and walks of snow. Both have helped Mom take in her garden....I have seen Neil clearing snow for other neighbours on the street. **Carl Leary** was nominated by Alex Maxwell. "In May 2006 I suffered a stroke and was unable to do many things, such as cutting grass or shovelling snow. Carl looked after these things for me. He continues to help me whenever he can by looking after our house and cats when my wife and I are away....Carl takes an interest in the neighbourhood and watches out for strange vehicles in the area....He knows the people in the neighbourhood and is well liked and respected...He offers to help any neighbour who needs assistance." **Joe Pollock** was nominated by Donna Shilka because "Joe has helped many neighbors with snowplowing of their driveways for many years. He also keeps a close eye on neighborhood properties. **Eddie and Lida Poloprutsky** were nominated by Joe and Mary Dobrich, who say "Eddie and Lida are always available to help out. We have witnessed occasions when they have not only had to keep an eye on two or three homes (at the same time) but also take responsibility for feeding their pets. Need your plants watered or your greenhouse monitored for a couple of days, a week or more? No problem, Eddie and Lida will be there for you. Their love of animals makes them major caregivers for most of the pets in our neighborhood...We could not have asked for better neighbors or friends than the Poloprutsky's. The value of a good neighbour is incalculable and we have certainly been blessed."
