2011 ASSESSMENT AND PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION

Combined Assessment and Property Tax Notices are now mailed. The Town of Fairview Property Tax consists of municipal and education taxes and local improvement taxes where applicable. If you wish to appeal your assessment, you must submit your application with the applicable fee to the Town Office within the deadline specified on your notice.

Taxes are due on June 30, 2011. A 15% penalty will be applied on the current amount after the due date. **Failure to receive a tax notice is not considered sufficient reason for non-payment of property taxes.**

The Town of Fairview acts as a school tax collector on behalf of the province and the separate school board. School taxes are not subject to control or review by the Town of Fairview.

Municipal taxes are levied by adopted mill rate for the purpose of providing municipal services. The tax is calculated by multiplying the mill rate by the assessed value of property. One mill represents \$1.00 tax for every \$1,000.00 assessment value. For information on taxation matters, contact the Town Office.
