Only properties in residential areas are eligible. (Town reserves the right to withdraw this incentive in the case of water shortages due to dry weather or mechanical problems.)

NOTICE OF UTILITY RATES INCREASE

Effective May 1, 2011, utility rates have increased as follows:
 Residential Minimum Rate has increased from \$52.30 to \$55.35/mo
 Commercial Minimum Rate has increased from \$49.50 to \$50.90/mo
 Car Wash Rate has increased from \$99.50 to \$102.40/mo
 Restaurant Rate has increased from \$68.50 to \$70.45/mo
 Truck Fill Rate has increased from \$3.50 to \$5.00 per cubic metre

These rates are pursuant to Bylaw 971/UTIL/2011 which received third reading at regular council meeting held April 19, 2011.

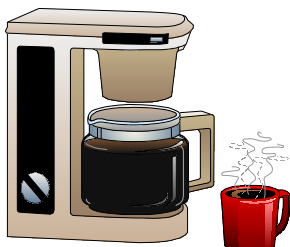
