

BYLAW No. 1085/GEN/2023

OF THE TOWN OF FAIRVIEW

A BYLAW FOR THE TOWN OF FAIRVIEW IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING METHODS FOR ADVERTISING STATUTORY NOTICES.

Whereas, Pursuant to section 606 and/ or 692 of the Municipal Government Act, a council must give notice of certain bylaws, resolutions, meetings, public hearings or other things by advertising in a newspaper or other publication circulating in the area, mailing or delivering a notice to every residence in the affected area or by another method provided for in a bylaw under section 606. 1; and

Whereas, Pursuant to section 606. 1(1) of the Municipal Government Act, a council may, by bylaw, provide for one or more methods, which may include electronic means, for advertising proposed bylaws, resolutions, meetings, public hearings, and other things referred to in section 606 and/ or 692; and

Whereas, Council is satisfied that the advertising method set out in this Bylaw is likely to bring matters advertised by that method to the attention of substantially all residents in the area to which the bylaw, resolution or other thing relates or in which the meeting or hearing is to be held;.

NOW THEREFORE, Council of the Town of Fairview, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

Title

This Bylaw may be cited as the "Statutory Advertising Bylaw" for the Town of Fairview

Effective Date and Repeal

Should any provision of this bylaw be deemed invalid, then the invalid provision shall be severed, and the remaining bylaw shall be maintained.

This bylaw shall be enacted upon the third and final reading.

1. Advertising Method

- 1.1. Any notice required to be advertised under section 606 and/ or 692 of the Municipal Government Act of a bylaw, resolution, meeting, public hearing or other thing may be given, in accordance with the timelines prescribed in section 606 and/ or 692;
- 1.2. Electronically by posting the notice prominently for two consecutive weeks on the Town of Fairview official website; and/or
- 1.3. Electronically by posting the notice prominently for two weeks on any of the Town of Fairview's official social media sites; and/or
- 1.4. By posting the notice prominently for two weeks on the bulletin board provided for that purpose in the following municipal facilities: Town of Fairview Administrative Office; and/or
- 1.5. By publishing at least once a week for two consecutive weeks in at least one newspaper or other publication circulating publicly in the area to which the proposed bylaw, resolution or other thing relates, or in which the meeting or hearing is being held.
