

BYLAW No. 1102/TAX/2025

A BYLAW FOR THE TOWN OF FAIRVIEW IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,

FOR THE PURPOSE OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHING THE TOWN OF FAIRVIEW FOR THE 2025 TAXATION YEAR

This Bylaw may be cited as "2025 TAX RATE BYLAW"

Whereas, the Town of Fairview has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the municipal revenues, expenses and expenditures as required, at the council meeting held on April 15th, 2025; and

Whereas, the estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than property taxation is estimated at \$5,245,095;

Whereas, the estimated municipal expenses (excluding non-cash items but including amounts required to repay principal debt) set out in the budget for the Town of Fairview for 2025 totaled \$7,815,691;

Whereas, the estimated amount required for transfers to capital reserves to be raised by municipal taxation is \$700,600;

Whereas, the estimated amount required for current year capital expenditures to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$150,000, and

Therefore, the total amount to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$3,421,196.

Whereas, the Council of the Town of Fairview is required each year to levy on the assessed value of all taxable property, tax rates sufficient to meet the estimated expenditures and the requisitions; and

Whereas, the Council is authorized to sub-classify assessed property, and to establish different rates of taxation in respect to each sub-class of property, subject to the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26. Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000; and

Whereas, Section 357 (1) of the Municipal Government Act provides that the Municipal Tax Bylaw "may specify a minimum amount payable as property tax" and the Town of Fairview has resolved to establish a minimum tax;

Whereas, the assessed value of all property in the Town of Fairview as shown on the assessment roll is:

Now therefore under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Town of Fairview, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all taxable property as shown on the assessment roll of the Town of Fairview:

- 2. Where the application of the tax rates established by the Bylaw to the assessment of any taxable property would result in a total municipal levy payable of less than \$750, the minimum municipal tax shall be assessed at \$750 and deemed to be the minimum municipal tax payable.
- 3. That all 2025 Town of Fairview property taxes shall be due and payable on or before June 30, 2025, with the exception of any properties on the tax instalment plan.
- 4. A penalty of 15% will be imposed on all current property tax amounts levied in 2025 that remain unpaid after June 30, 2025.
- 5. A penalty of 15% will be imposed on all outstanding property tax amounts that remain unpaid after December 31, 2025.
- 6. That this bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading.

NOW THEREFORE, Council of the Town of Fairview, duly assembled, enacts as follows:
