



PROMPTING PREPAREDNESS

Routine preparedness messages to build capacity for risk reduction education in Alberta

Emergencies can happen with little warning, disrupt access to everyday services we rely on and may require you to shelter in place or evacuate. Preparing emergency supplies in advance helps you and your loved ones stay safe. #BePrepared:

Learn the difference between gathering supplies and building an emergency kit. Don't forget to share your knowledge with loved ones by getting them involved too. Collect items from around your home that aren't being used to build an inventory of emergency supplies. An old backpack/duffle bag, for example, is a low-cost start of an emergency kit. Consider your households unique needs when adding items to your supplies. For example, medications, formula for babies, a tire patch kit for a wheelchair, or pet food.

Preparing emergency supplies is one small step to building self-reliance and protecting you and your loved ones before, during and after an emergency. Use Be Prepared programming and resources to learn about more preparedness actions you can take.

HECK NO, We don't want to tow!

- No parking on the street or any other public property at the same location for a period longer than 72 hours.

- No parking in disabled parking stall, unless a valid handicapped placard is displayed.
- No unattached trailers parked on the street at any time.
- No attached trailers parked on the street for longer than 48 hours.

Please note that these bylaws are applicable year-round, but are enforced more strictly in the winter due to snow clearing operations, narrower roadways and more hazardous road conditions.



ANIMAL & RESPONSIBLE PET OWNERSHIP BYLAW

BYLAW REMINDERS: 1077/AC/2022

- All dog and cat owners are required to license animals over three months old
- Residents of Country View Estates and North View Estates who are permitted horses and chickens are required to obtain unit licences
- No more than four animals with a max. of three dogs allowed
- Fine for keeping more than the maximum number of animals allowed is \$200
- No livestock is allowed within town limits
- Fine for failing to obtain a dog licence is \$100, failure to wear licence is \$75
- Fine for failing to obtain a cat licence is \$30, failure to wear licence is \$20
- Dog or cat licences are \$20 for non-spayed or non-neutered, and \$10 for spayed or neutered

Town Utility Bills

Your utility bills are mailed out at the beginning of each month (for the previous month's consumption). New radio frequency meters have been installed in almost all the households and businesses. You will receive an accurate monthly bill for actual consumption. You will be charged \$3.41 per cubic meter for residential accounts and non-residential accounts.

In addition to the consumption rate for water you will be charged a flat rate for the Sewer service for residential and non-residential accounts, and a flat rate monthly Capital Replacement fee.



If your bill is exceedingly high, check your toilet(s), faucets, humidifiers, icemakers and outdoor taps for leaks.

We are pleased to offer our residents the option of paperless billing. Property owners can view their bills online via our Customer Portal. They will receive an email when their billing is available. 

Ready, Set, Build!

What do you need for the Development Permit?

Legal Address – Lot, Block, Plan
Civic Address – To determine Land Use Zone

Site Plan – Birds eye view of your property. Includes location of property lines, distance of existing and proposed from property lines, size of buildings, access to street or lane, size of lot

Building Plans – includes floor plan, elevations, exterior finishing

Fees

\$50.00 – For Garage and Additions less than \$25,000.00

\$50.00 – Home based business

\$200.00 – Conforming developments over \$25,000

\$250.00 – Non-Conforming Developments

\$250.00 – Application to Amend Land Use Bylaw, Municipal Development Plan or Statutory Plan

Late Fee – Double above fee, when applying after development has started

Application fees are to recover costs associated with administration time, appeals, notices and advertising.

Planning on building signage, a house, garage, shed, deck, fire pit, adding on or starting a home-based business?

You will require a development permit from the Town of Fairview.

What's Next?:

Construction is not to start until after the issuance of the Development Permit. Permits for discretionary uses or require a variance will be subject to condition that it does not become effective until 21 days after the date of issuance. The decision can be appealed within 21 days.

The proposed development may require building, electrical, plumbing and gas permits which may be a condition of the development permit. You will require the development permit to get the other permits. Building permits and inspections are necessary to ensure construction meets provincial building safety codes.

Home-Based Businesses require an annual license with a fee of \$75


