

"We believe that no kid should be left on the sidelines and **ALL** should be given the opportunity to experience the positive benefits of organized sports.

KidSport provides support to children in order to remove financial barriers that prevent them from playing organized sport."

Funds are for children from low-income families. Residents of Fairview, the MD of Fairview, Hines Creek and the MD of Clear Hills are eligible to apply.

- Funds are only for activities that demonstrate a sustained sport experience with qualified instructors.
- Cultural and recreational activities will be considered (KidSport Fairview fundraises for these separately.)
- KidSport will issue funds only to recognized organizations on behalf of the individual.

- There is a maximum amount of \$250/ calendar year/athlete.
- Only children ages 5-18 are eligible.
- Applications for programs that are already complete will not be issued.

The fund distribution review committee will endeavor to process applications within 30 days. All applications are kept in strict **confidentiality**.

AQUATIC CENTRE INFO

The Fairview Regional Aquatic Centre offers a five lane, 25-metre lap pool and a zero-depth wading pool. The pools have multiple water features including river jets and fountain canes. The facility also has a 150-foot water slide - the biggest in the Peace Country, a Tarzan rope, skywalker hanging monkey bars, a rock climbing wall and a 20 person hot tub with wheelchair access.

The centre offers many levels of aquatic programming including but not limited to: adult lane swim, swimming lessons, aqua-fit classes, and junior lifeguard training.

Town Utility Bills

Your utility bills are mailed out at the beginning of each month (for the previous month's consumption). New radio frequency meters have been installed in almost all the households and businesses. You will receive an accurate monthly bill for actual consumption. You will be charged \$3.41 per cubic meter for residential accounts and non-residential accounts.

In addition to the consumption rate for water you will be charged a flat rate for the Sewer service for residential and non-residential accounts, and a flat rate monthly Capital Replacement fee.



If your bill is exceedingly high, check your toilet(s), faucets, humidifiers, icemakers and outdoor taps for leaks.

We are pleased to offer our residents the option of paperless billing. Property owners can view their bills online via our Customer Portal. They will receive an email when their billing is available. As an incentive to sign-up for this service, there is currently a \$1 credit per month for signing up.






ANIMAL & RESPONSIBLE PET OWNERSHIP BYLAW

BYLAW REMINDERS: 1077/AC/2022

- All dog and cat owners are required to license animals over three months old
- Residents of Country View Estates and North View Estates who are permitted horses and chickens are required to obtain unit licences
- No more than four animals with a max. of three dogs allowed
- Fine for keeping more than the maximum number of animals allowed is \$200
- No livestock is allowed within town limits
- Fine for failing to obtain a dog licence is \$100, failure to wear licence is \$75
- Fine for failing to obtain a cat licence is \$30, failure to wear licence is \$20
- Dog or cat licences are \$20 for non-spayed or non-neutered, and \$10 for spayed or neutered

Application fees are to recover costs associated with administration time, appeals, notices and advertising.

Planning on building signage, a house, garage, shed, deck, fire pit, adding on or starting a home-based business?

You will require a development permit from the Town of Fairview.

What's Next?:

Construction is not to start until after the issuance of the Development Permit. Permits for discretionary uses or require a variance will be subject to condition that it does not become effective until 21 days after the date of issuance. The decision can be appealed within 21 days.

The proposed development may require building, electrical, plumbing and gas permits which may be a condition of the development permit. You will require the development permit to get the other permits. Building permits and inspections are necessary to ensure construction meets provincial building safety codes.

Are You Prepared for an Emergency?

1. Know the Risks:

Blizzards, Extreme Cold, Extreme Heat, Floods, Wildfires, Power outages, Winter storms, Tornadoes

2. Make a Plan:

- Plan how and where to meet
 - Where in your home
 - Safe meeting place outside of your home
- Alternate places to stay such as family and friends outside of your neighborhood
- Emergency Exits - Out of your home
 - Out of your neighborhood - Out of your Town

3. Educate

- Know the emergency plans in your workplace and your children's school, emergency contact information, the

location of fire extinguishers, water valve, electrical box, gas valve, all Family members know how to contact emergency services

4. Have an Emergency Kit

Have some basic supplies so you and your family are prepared to be self-sufficient for at least 72 hours. Make sure your kit is easy to carry and everyone in the house knows where it is. Keep it portable in case you need to leave.


