



## Council Highlights

April 7, 2026

**Public Hearing:** A public hearing was held for the rezoning of Lot 2, Block 1 (Plan 8122300) from Secondary Commercial (C-2) to Light Industrial (M-1). Council approved the land use amendment bylaw.

**Development:** The Municipal Planning Commission approved Phase 2 of the apartment development on 102 Avenue.

**Education:** Holy Family Catholic School Division attended as a delegation and provided updates on planning for the new school.

**Budgets:** The 2026 Operating and Capital Budgets will be presented for adoption on April 21. The Tax Rate Bylaw will follow on May 5, with tax notices due June 30.

**Financial Statements:** Auditors will present the 2025 Audited Financial Statements at the April 21 meeting.

**Economic Development:** The Economic Development Committee is supporting local initiatives:

- \$4,000 contribution to the Farmer’s Market
  - \$1,000 contribution to Lemonade Day
- Be sure to support local vendors and events!

**Aquatic Centre:** Council awarded the Aquatic Centre basin refurbishment project to RECA Vinyl Works for \$200,864.73. Work is scheduled for Nov. 15 – Dec. 20.

**Recreation Centre:** Notice was received from NWP regarding the transfer of Recreation Centre leases to the province. This includes facilities currently leased and operated in partnership with the Town.

**Pilot Program:** A Pet Therapy pilot program bylaw was approved for the long-term care facility.

**Policy and Procedure:** An updated Donation Policy is being developed and will come forward April 21.

**Provincial Bills:** Bill 28 was introduced by the Province, impacting municipalities in areas such as growth, housing, taxation, governance, and transparency.
