Fairview Campus

- The Northern Lakes College Fairview Campus Grand Opening was held August 25 at 1:30 p.m. The Fairview campus has officially transferred from Northwestern Polytechnic to Northern Lakes College.
- Several campus items have been transferred to the Fairview College Campus Society, including art, cattle, farm equipment and supplies, along with various other items.

Infrastructure and Development

- The 102 Avenue East extension project has been deferred to 2027 and will be incorporated into the 104 Avenue infrastructure project.
- The flower beds along 101 Avenue will be converted to xeriscaping.
- Council approved adding an additional accessible parking stall in front of the Golden Age Centre/Dentist office.
- New signage indicating the applicable times for school and playground zones are being installed.

Bylaws and Municipal Governance

- Council is considering amendments to the Community Standards Bylaw to address unsightly or dangerous vegetation and trees on private property.
- Council denied a request to waive penalty charges associated with late payment of property taxes.

Community Partnerships, Funding, Business and Public Safety

- Council approved a \$500 donation to the Peace Country Beef & Forage Association for the Northern Women in Agriculture Conference, taking place February 18–19, 2027.
- Chamber of Commerce Business Awards: Nominations are now open. The Business Awards event is scheduled for October 23, and Glow Ball will take place September 11.
- RCMP Crime Statistics: Council received the latest quarterly statistics, which indicate an overall downward trend in crime since 2022.
