ONLINE PAYMENTS

Do you pay your taxes and/or utilities online? Did you pay before the due date and your payments are not reflected on your current bill? Time to check if your account number information is up to date in your banking portal.

Please verify that the account number you are paying through online banking matches your invoice you are paying, you may be building a huge credit on an inactive account.

The Fairview Town Office is only required to apply the payments to the accounts you have entered in your online banking app. If we notice that the account entered is inactive we will contact you to change that information but the responsibility to have the correct account information entered is yours, please check and update your account if necessary.



EMERGENCY ADDRESSING

We would like to remind all residents to ensure your house numbers are clearly visible from the road. Emergency responders cannot find you, when the seconds count, if your house number is not clearly displayed, visible from the street or visible at night. This could cost you time in an emergency! To ensure your addressing is correct, reference your Utility Bill and Tax Notice.

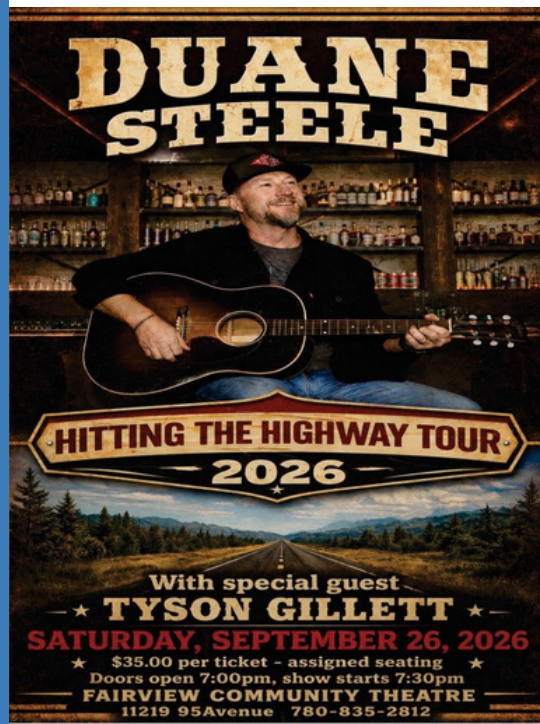
