

### Delegations:

- Council presented Provincial recognition to the U18 Female B Hockey Team for their 2026 Provincial Gold Medal Championship. Congratulations on an outstanding achievement!
- Council also recognized Joe Larsback for his incredible success in Track & Field at both the Provincial and National levels. Joe earned 14 gold medals between 2022–2025. Great job, Joe!
- The Fairview Library attended as a delegation to provide an update on their programs and services. The library will now be able to provide accessible resources and will be celebrating 88 years of service this year. Be sure to check out all their new offerings!

### Proposals:

- A Request for Proposal (RFP) is currently out for the RCMP Museum building.
- An RFP will soon be issued for the development of a Community Facilities and Recreation Strategy. This joint project between the Town and the MD will include partnerships with School Divisions and user groups. The 12–18 month project will be funded through a provincial grant.

**Taxes:** The Tax Rate Bylaw was approved. Municipal residential and non-residential tax rates remain the same as last year and have not increased since 2013. However, provincial education requisition rates have increased by over 10%, which will affect overall property taxes.

### Community:

- Council approved resurfacing and upgrades to the current Tennis Courts by the arena. The new surface will accommodate two tennis courts or up to six pickleball courts.
- The Fairview Library is partnering with the Town to install Book Barns in three public locations throughout town later this summer.
- Council approved a \$500 sponsorship to the Peace Country Beef & Forage Association for their Junior Agrarian Summer Program.
- Did you know the Fairview Chamber of Commerce turns 50 next year?
- The Grass Bin is now back on site. Please place grass only in the bin — no sticks, garbage, or plastic. Those items can be taken to the landfill. Continued misuse may result in the service being discontinued.
- House & Yard Clean Up Day is Saturday, May 9 from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. at the Public Works shop.
- Free Stuff Day follows on Sunday from 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
- The Community Wide Garage Sale will take place May 28–30.
