PROPERTY ASSESSMENT NOTICES

The assessment notices were remailed on February 8th, 2024. Tax notices will be mailed out in May. If you did not receive your assessment notice, please call the Town Office, and request a notice, if you are on our portal, please check the portal for your notice. All non-linear assessment complaints for the Town of Fairview along with the applicable fees are due by April 16th, 2024. An assessment complaint must be filled out using the Government of Alberta Assessment Review Board Complaint Form (LGS1402). This form can be provided to you by the Town of Fairview office or you can download it from the Municipal Affairs website at:
