Community Standards Bylaw

Reminding property owners to maintain homes and yards

Part III - Nuisances and Unsightly or Dangerous Premises

- do no store abandoned equipment or abandoned vehicles
 - do not store household applicances and furniture on the property exterior
- properly dispose of hazardous materials and toxins
- Bylaw Highlights . dispose of refuse and debris
 - prune trees and shrubs and ensure no encroachment or damage to adjacent properties
 - mow grass that is taller than 10 cm
 - assess for weeds and invasive species
 - no storage of composting material in front yard
 - Keep property in a REASONABLE state of repair, including windows, siding, roofing materials, eaves etc.
