PROPERTY TAX NOTICES

The property tax notices will be mailed out in May. If you do not receive your property tax notice by the end of May, check the Customer Portal or please email: reception@fairview.ca.

NOT RECEIVING A PROPERTY TAX NOTICE DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A **REASON FOR NONPAYMENT.** The 2023 property taxes are due June 30th, 2023 except for the property owners on the Tax Installment Plan.

Notice to the owners of the mobile homes in the Fairview Estates Mobile Home Park – You DO pay property tax to the Town of Fairview on your mobile home.

A penalty of 15% will be imposed on all property tax amounts levied in 2023 that remain unpaid after June 30, 2023. An additional penalty of 15% will be imposed of all outstanding property tax amounts that remain unpaid after December 31, 2023.

BOULEVARD SWEEPING

Town of Fairview Parks staff will begin boulevard sweeping the residential areas this month. If you **do not** wish to have your area swept, please visibly mark off your grass or place a sign sizable enough for crews to see on your grass. If your boulevard was missed please call the office or Cole Wiebe at 780-834-7239. Please stay back 30 meters. Sweepers create a dust cloud and operators sight line is limited.

> The grass bin will be back in May! Please do not put grass clippings into the blue bin. The only items that should go in the blue bin are newsprint, heavy paper (magazines), flyers, mixed paper, boxboard, cardboard, cans, beverage containers, and hard plastics #1 - 7. Contaminated loads of recycling end up in the landfill instead of recycling.

Program Information

Thank you for your interest in the Fairview & Area FCSS Volunteer Driver Program.

The purpose of the Volunteer
Driver Program is to assist those
who do not have access to
affordable transportation
between communities, mainly for
their healthcare appointments.

Clients can feel comfortable knowing that our Volunteer Drivers are screened to a rigorous level to insure that they will have a safe and pleasant trip.

Administration

All rides for the program will be booked, recorded and dispatched through the Fairview & Area FCSS office.

The FCSS Coordinator will take bookings from clients, tentatively accept the booking, and try to match the client with an appropriate volunteer.

Once volunteer availability is determined, the FCSS Coordinator will then confirm the ride with the client and provide a pick-up time.

This will be done within 7 business days.

Cancelling a trip due to weather is at the discretion of the driver. Safety is always the most important priority. If a trip needs to be cancelled, we will do our best to notify you immediately.

Expense Recovery Fee

Fairview & Area FCSS receives no funds for this program. The expense recovery fee goes 100% to your driver to reimburse them for gas and parking expenses for your trip. The current rate of expense recovery fees, has been set at .50/km.
