SNOW REMOVAL SCHEDULE

As we gear up for the 2025-2026 winter season, we would like to remind everyone to please be patient. The Plowing Schedule is as follows: "Priority 1" areas 101, 103, 105 and 108 Avenues, these are considered emergency routes. "Priority 2" areas are 102 Avenue between 109 and 111 Streets. Snow will be windrowed and removed immediately, after which Main Street will be windrowed. "Priority 3" are hill roads: 100, 103, 106, 107, 108, 109, 111, 112, 115, 116 Streets. "Priority 4" are 102, 104, 106, 107, 109 and 113 Avenues, and "Priority 5" are residential areas and the remainder of downtown.

GO SLOW! KEEP AN EYE OUT FOR SNOW CLEARING EQUIPMENT

Drivers and pedestrians are asked to use extreme caution around the large machines during snow removal. Do not drive under or close to the loader bucket. When machinery is backing up, please keep a safe distance away. If you are too close, you are not visible in the mirrors. When meeting equipment, be certain you have eye contact with the operator before you pass. They will do their best to make room for you to pass them safely.

BYLAW REMINDERS: 965/TR/2010

Traffic Control Bylaw

NO PARKING

- Within 1.5m of a driveway, private road, garage or electrical transformer
- Within 4.5m of an intersection
- Within 5m of a fire hydrant, stop sign or yield sign, or marked crosswalk
- Facing oncoming traffic
- On curbs or boulevards
- In an alley restricting traffic
- On any public roadway longer than 72 hours
- Holiday trailers (RV's) on any public roadway longer than 48 hours
- Detached Trailers

DID YOU KNOW?

The Town of Fairview has an online portal that will allow you to log in and view your current account balances, invoices and receipts and make your payments.

When you sign up for this online service, you will receive email notices about your Personal/Business Utility bills each month and yearly Tax Notices. You will then be able to log in using your new account credentials to check your balances and securely make online payments.

Sign-up instructions are printed on the back of each Utility bill or Tax Notice along with your unique Sign-up Key (required first time only).

Fairview Health Professional Enhancement Committee Scholarship Program



This scholarship is intended for high school students, students already in a qualifying program, and adults considering enrolling in a medical or health-related program in person or online. It is designed to provide financial support to students entering a healthcare or medical-related program and encourage them to live and work in the Fairview region.

A total of up to four \$500 scholarships per year are available. Applicants must reside in the Town of Fairview, MD of Fairview, Hines Creek, or Clear Hills County. The Scholarship Selection Committee will review applications, and successful applicants will be notified each year in early February. Applicants are welcome to re-apply annually. Deadline to apply is December 31, 2025.


