



Council Highlights

September 2, 2025

RCMP Update – Cst. Popic presented the quarterly report. Overall crime statistics are down. The detachment is expecting a new Sergeant soon. Residents are reminded to contact the RCMP directly with any concerns.

Infrastructure Projects – The 102 Ave waterline replacement and 103 Ave sewer line replacement are nearly complete, with paving next. The paving contractor will also patch water break repairs from this spring.

Northwest Polytechnic – Student intake orientations were recently held.

Fire Department – The Fairview Volunteer Fire Department is set to receive its new Rescue Truck soon. This project has been two years in the making.

FCSS Services Fair – Taking place September 11 at the Legion Hall. A great opportunity to check out local services and sign up for fall and winter activities.

Aquatic Centre – The Fairview Regional Aquatic Centre will be closed for a planned shutdown October 19–November 1. A shorter closure will follow later this year for HVAC replacement (dates TBD).

Strategic Plan – Council adopted a new three-year strategic plan, which will be posted on the Town’s website.

Intermunicipal Collaboration – The Town and MD of Fairview #136 have entered into a new ICF agreement to guide shared services.

Cemetery Operations – Council approved an agreement with the MD for cemetery operations.

Franchise Fees – No changes will be made to the ATCO power and gas franchise rates.

Pleasant Valley Senior Manor – Owners are moving ahead with Phase 2 (18 additional units). Council approved their request for the same tax incentive as Phase 1 and the temporary use of a portion of 102 Ave for construction staging.
