School and Playground Zones

Playground Times are in effect every day from 8:30 am to 1 hour after sunset



School Zone Times
(school days only) are:
8:00 am to 9:30 am
11:30 am to 1:30 pm
3:00 pm to 4:30 pm



- The speed limit for school and playground zones is 30km/hr
- A school zone ends where a traffic sign indicates a higher speed or the end of the school zone
- Do not pass another vehicle travelling in the same direction within a school zone, when the school zone is in effect
- Children and young adults may be walking or crossing the road and you must use caution when driving through a school or playground area
