



## Town Utility Bills

Your utility bills are mailed out at the beginning of each month (for the previous month's consumption). New radio frequency meters have been installed in almost all the households and businesses. You will receive an accurate monthly bill for actual consumption. You will be charged \$3.00 per cubic meter for residential accounts and non-residential accounts.

In addition to the consumption rate for water you will be charged a flat rate for the Sewer service for residential and non-residential accounts, and a flat rate monthly Capital Replacement fee.

If your bill is exceedingly high, check your toilet(s), faucets, humidifiers, icemakers and outdoor taps for leaks.


We are pleased to offer our residents the option of paperless billing. This means that you would receive an email copy of your bill each month instead of the paper copy in the mail. As an incentive to sign-up for this service, there is currently a \$1 credit per month for signing up.



## COMMUNITY STANDARDS

### BYLAW 1047/GEN/2018

**NUISANCE:** accumulation of garbage on property; long grass and/or presence of noxious weeds; abandoned vehicles, equipment, or appliances; derelict structures or buildings with significant deterioration, broken or missing windows/doors, chipping, peeling or absence of painted areas. (S. 3 a-h)

**NOISE:** a person may be guilty of a contravention of Section 4 (Noise) if the decibel level exceeds prescribed limits or is reasonable likely to disturb the peace outside weekday hours: any non holiday Monday – Friday between the hours of 7:00 am and 10:00 pm; or weekend hours: any Saturday, Sunday or (AB) statutory holiday between the hours of 9:00 am and 10:00 pm. (S. 4 a-l)

**FINES:** contraventions of the BYLAW 1047/GEN/2018 can result in fines as listed in BYLAW 1046 /GEN/2018



# ANIMAL CONTROL

The Town's Animal Control Bylaw dictates that an owner of an animal is guilty of an offence if:

- the animal is not licensed
- barking or howling disturbs others
- the animal causes property damage
- the animal is in an area where a sign prohibits pets
- the animal bites, attacks, barks at or threatens a person or another animal
- the animal defecates on property not belonging to the owner, and the defecation is not immediately removed and disposed of in a sanitary manner

Dog and cat owners are ultimately responsible for their pets. Please, respect your neighbors, take proper care of your pets and limit yourself to what you are able to handle. Your neighbors have a right to peace and quiet in their homes and to be able to walk the streets and trails without being annoyed or frightened.

# REDUCE USE CYCLE

All residential garbage and recyclables are collected on Wednesdays by Prairie Disposal's automated collection system. Every residence has been allocated one black bin for household waste and one blue bin for recyclables. The bins are provided at no charge, however if a bin is lost or damaged, the resident will be responsible for the replacement cost. Place both bins on the street with wheels touching the curb, one metre of clearance between each bin and any other object, such as a vehicle.

What if I can't get all my garbage in the cart? The equivalent of three bags will fit in the cart. If your cart is overflowing (lid will not close), it will not be collected. Additional bags placed at the curb will be picked up if they have a "bag tag" sticker which can be purchased at the Town office.

What can go in the blue recycling bin? Newsprint, heavy paper, mixed paper, box board, cardboard, rinsed food cans, rinsed beverage containers, hard plastics #1 to 7 and deposit items.

What should not go into my blue recycling bin? Plastic toys, bubble wrap, plastic bags/film, styrofoam, glass, ceramics, toxic items, electronics, small appliances, diapers, scrap metal or wood, food or yard waste, unrinsed food containers, soiled paper (used tissue or paper towel, pizza boxes smeared with cheese etc.), soiled containers.

What can go in the black garbage cart? Any bagged household garbage that you would normally place out for collection should be placed in the black cart. Absolutely no hazardous materials or loose garbage.



Please remove your emptied bins from the street the same day. This is crucial for both snow removal purposes and general neighborhood courtesy.







# CLEAR HILLS COUNTY

Located 630 kilometres north of Edmonton in the beautiful Peace Region of north western Alberta, along the British Columbia border, Clear Hills County has plenty to offer. The mighty Peace River forming part of the southern boundary, and the Clear Hills to the north, are natural features that contribute to the charm and appeal of the County. Driving through the County on Highway 64 is a beautiful

alternative route to Alaska and British Columbia, providing the opportunity to pass through two stunning river crossings; the Clear River and the Beaton River. This well maintained highway is the road of choice for those seeking picturesque scenery and is known for sightings of deer and other wildlife and its vast boreal forest.

### CARTER CAMP

Located on the banks of the Peace River 25 kms west of Hines Creek off Hwy 685. Rustic camping, hiking, picnic shelter, boat launch, fishing, playground, RV station.

### CLEAR RIVER CAMPGROUND

Located on Hwy 64, east of Cleardale. Camping, firepits, playground, trailer dumping facility, large group camping area.

### CLEARDALE GOLF COURSE

Located on Hwy 64, 5.5 kms west of Cleardale. Nine holes, sand greens, and picnic area.

### GEORGE LAKE

4.5kms south of Hines Creek on Hwy 64. Wonderful boating lake, good for water skiing. Great area for bird watching. Boat launch, beach area, horseshoes, playground, picnic shelter, and 26 large powered camp stalls. Home of the annual George Lake Music Festival every Sept. long weekend.

### HINES CREEK GOLF COURSE

Nine challenging holes set on a beautiful treed property 6 kms south of Hines Creek just off Hwy.64. Hines Creek meanders through the course, coming into play on five holes.

### MANY ISLANDS

6.5 kms southwest of Worsley off Hwy 64. Located on the banks of the Peace River, picnic shelter, boat launch, fishing, horseshoe pit, playground, hiking trails.

### OLE'S LAKE

49 kms southwest of Worsley off Hwy 64. Boat launch, fishing, hiking trails, camp stalls.

### RUNNING LAKE

8 kms east, 22 km north of Worsley on Hwy 64. Fishing, boat launch, hiking trails.

### STONEY LAKE

20 kms north east of Hines Creek off Hwy 685. Camping, fishing, swimming, hiking, boat launch.

### SULPHUR LAKE

Rustic camping, fishing, swimming, & boating.

### WHISPERING PINES SKI HILL

25 km northwest of Worsley, Ski & Snowboard school, chalet and concession, chair lift.

**Ready, Set, Build!**

**What do you need for the Development Permit?**

**Legal Address** – Lot, Block, Plan  
**Civic Address** – To determine Land Use Zone

**Site Plan** – Birds eye view of your property. Includes location of property lines, distance of existing and proposed from property lines, size of buildings, access to street or lane, size of lot

**Building Plans** – includes floor plan, elevations, exterior finishing

**Fees**

**\$50.00** – For Garage and Additions less than \$25,000.00

**\$50.00** – Home based business

**\$200.00** – Conforming developments over \$25,000

**\$250.00** – Non-Conforming Developments

**\$250.00** – Application to Amend Land Use Bylaw, Municipal Development Plan or Statutory Plan

**Late Fee** – Double above fee, when applying after development has started

Application fees are to recover costs associated with administration time, appeals, notices and advertising.

**Planning on building signage, a house, garage, shed, deck, fire pit, adding on or starting a home-based business?**

**You will require a development permit from the Town of Fairview.**

**What's Next?:**

Construction is not to start until after the issuance of the Development Permit. Permits for discretionary uses or require a variance will be subject to condition that it does not become effective until 21 days after the date of issuance. The decision can be appealed within 21 days.

The proposed development may require building, electrical, plumbing and gas permits which may be a condition of the development permit. You will require the development permit to get the other permits. Building permits and inspections are necessary to ensure construction meets provincial building safety codes.
