PROPERTY ASSESSMENT NOTICES

The 2018 Assessment Notices will be mailed out by the end of the first week of February. Property Tax notices will be mailed out in May. If you did not receive your assessment notice for 2018 by February 16, 2018 please call the Town Office and request your notice. All non-linear assessment complaints for the Town of the Fairview along with the applicable fees are due 60 days after the mailing date. An assessment complaint must be filled out using the Government of Alberta Assessment Review Board Complaint Form (LGS1402). This form can be provided to you by the Town of Fairview office or you can download it from the Municipal Affairs website at www.municipalaffairs.alberta.ca. Assessments are based on market value as of July 1, 2017. You may appeal the assessed value of your property, but not the tax rate.
