A neighborhood is marked by the type of relationships established among its residents. The first step in building a great neighborhood is respecting those next door, down the street and around the corner.

The Mark of a Good Neighbor

- ✓ Neighbors and residents can safely walk on my sidewalk
- ✓ I always put my trash container away at the end of trash collection day
- ✓ I assist seniors in the neighborhood with heavy lifting or shoveling
- ✓ My property is clean and neat, and I help keep the entire neighborhood tidy
- ✓ A new neighbor warmly is welcomed
- ✓ There is no garbage around my home, near the curb, or in the alley
- ✓ I keep snow cleared and lawn mowed in a timely fashion
- ✓ My vehicles are parked legally, appropriately, and in consideration of others
- ✓ Gutters and down spouts on my house are clean and securely attached
- ✓ The paint on my house is in good condition and windows are in good repair
- ✓ Leaves and grass clippings are raked from my yard and properly disposed
- ✓ My address is clearly marked on my house for instant visibility
- ✓ Fencing surrounding my home is straight and intact
- ✓ My pets do not run at large
- ✓ When walking my dogs, I carry a plastic bag and use it
- ✓ I do not play loud music or have loud conversation after 10:00 p.m.
- ✓ I do not allow my dog(s) to bark excessively during the day
- ✓ I do not allow my dog(s) to bark at all during the night
- ✓ I will hold a "block party" so the neighborhood can get together
