Effective June 1, 2012, the Town of Fairview recycling program is changing. All residents will be given a blue recycling cart that "ALL" recyclables can be placed into

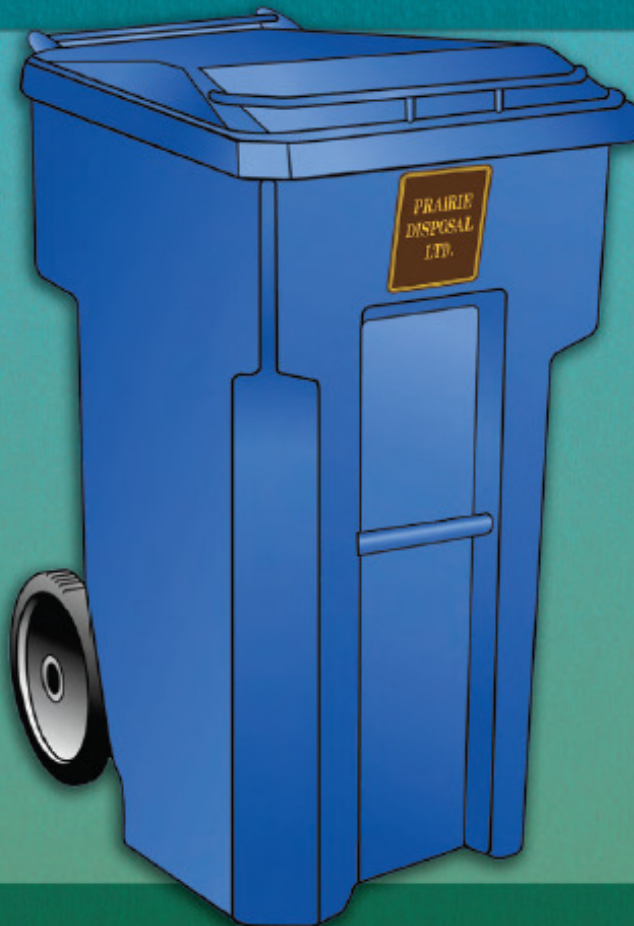
What can go in the mixed recycling cart?

Newsprint/Heavy Paper: newspaper, magazines, phone books, catalogs, flyers

Mixed Paper: office paper, junk mail, shredded paper, etc.

Boxboard/Cardboard: cereal boxes, pasta containers, etc.

Containers: food cans, beverage containers, hard plastics # 1-7, deposit items



What should not go into my blue mixed recyclables cart?

- ✗ Plastic toys
- ✗ Bubble wrap
- ✗ Plastic bags or plastic film
- ✗ Styrofoam (take to Eco-Centre)
- ✗ Glass of any kind
- ✗ Ceramics
- ✗ Toxic items (batteries, paint cans, aerosol cans)
- ✗ Electronics or small appliances
- ✗ Diapers
- ✗ Scrap metal or wood
- ✗ Food or yard waste
- ✗ Unrinsed or soiled food containers
- ✗ Soiled paper (used tissue or paper towel, pizza boxes smeared with cheese, etc.)
- ✗ Soiled containers

What day of the week is my mixed recyclables collected?

Recycle carts are to be placed at the curb each Wednesday (first day of collection June 6th) of every week for collection by 7:00 am. Please make sure they are placed 1 meter from any other objects. Refer to cart placement diagram.
