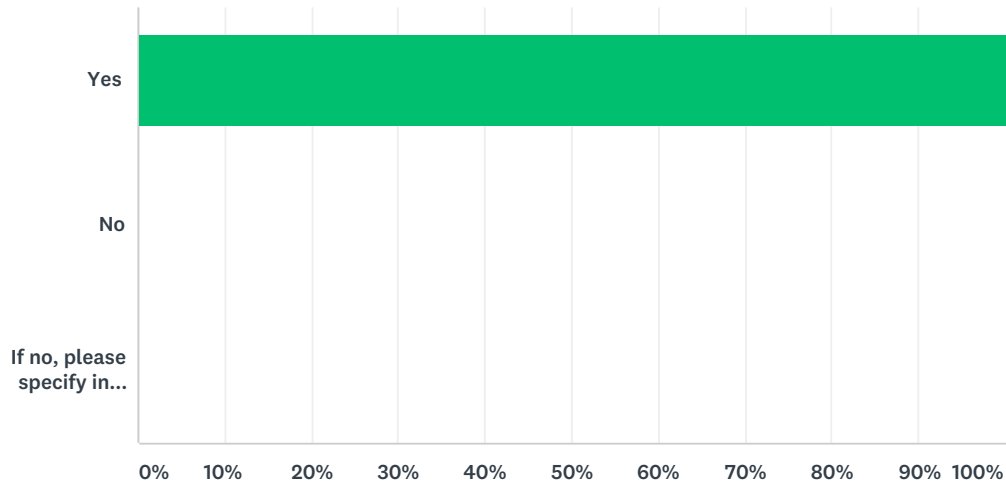


Q1 Are you a resident of the Town of Fairview?

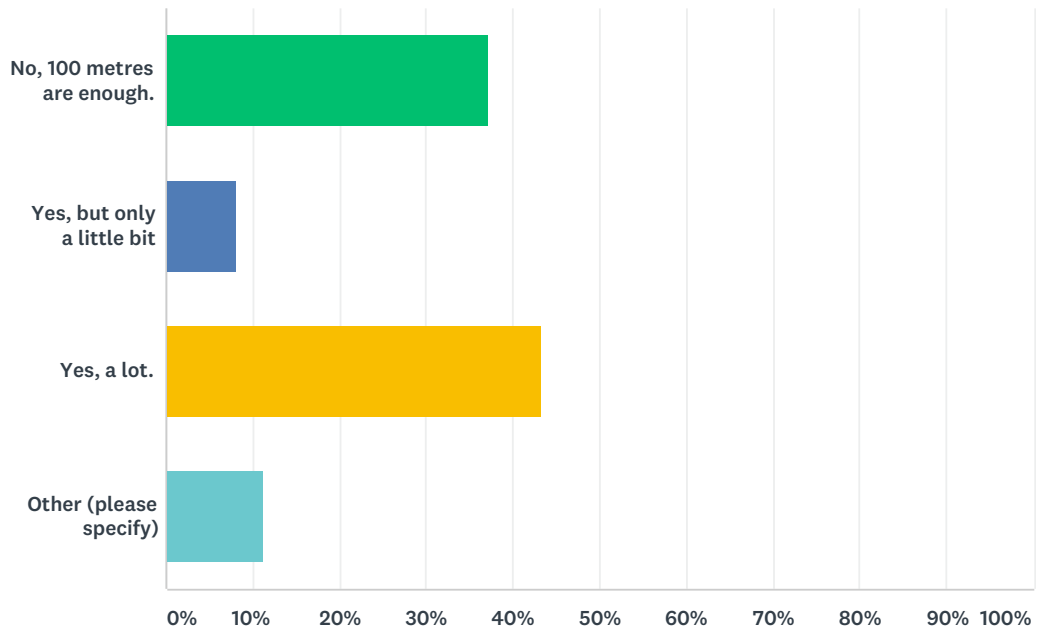

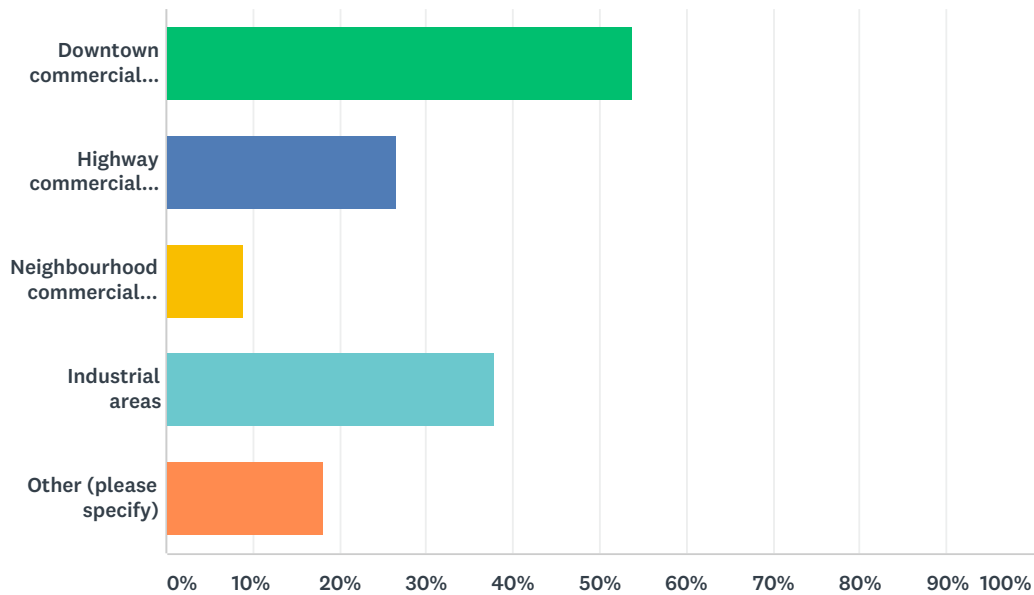

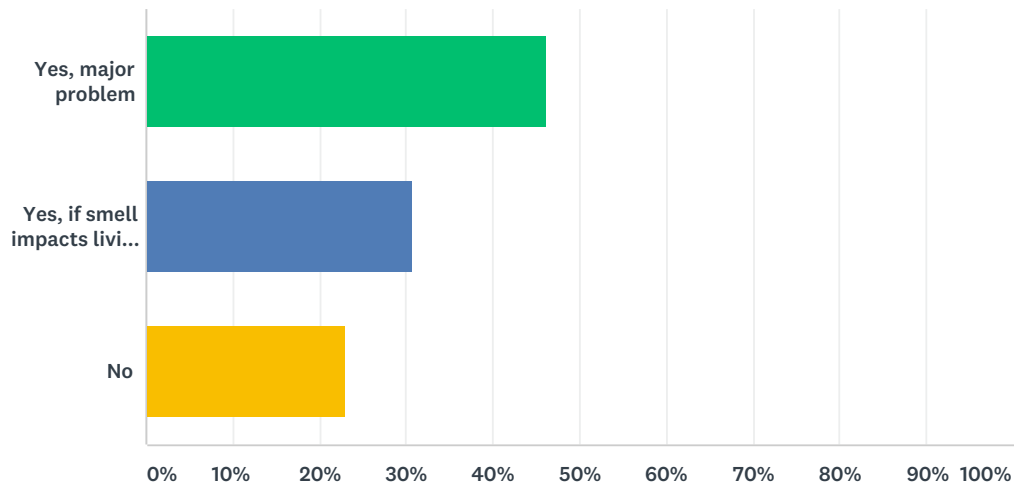

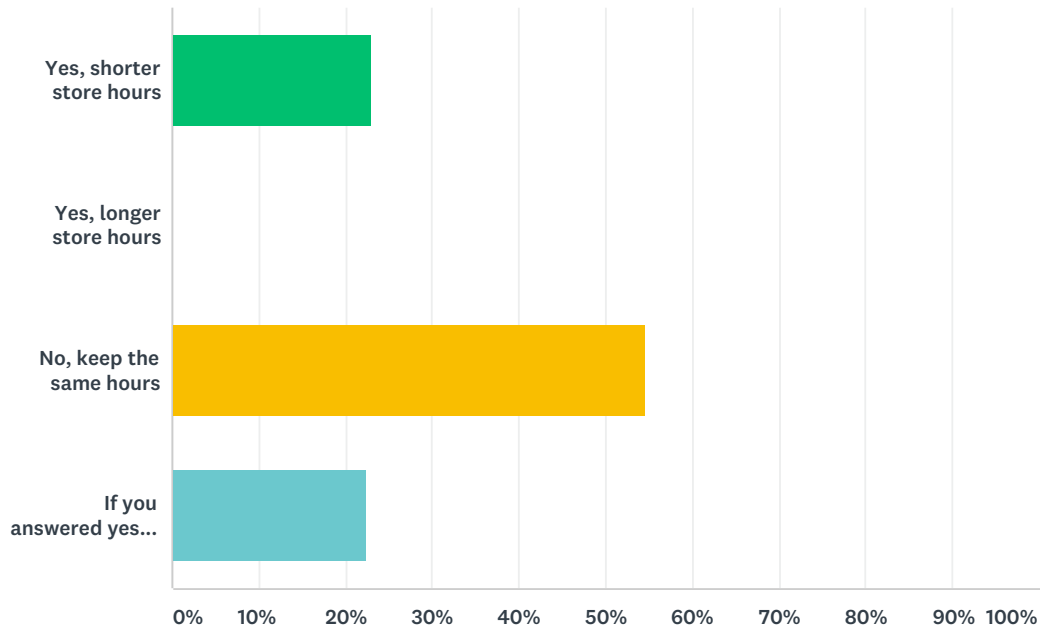
