In order to vote, you must produce identification for inspection. The identification must show your name and address and can be: Canadian government photo ID; bank/credit card statement or personal cheque; correspondence issued by a school, college or university; government cheque or cheque stub; income/property tax assessment notice; insurance policy or coverage card; letter from a public curator, public guardian or public trustee; pension plan statement of benefits, contributions or participation; residential lease or mortgage statement; statement of government benefits; utility bill; vehicle ownership, registration or insurance certificate; or a letter or form (attestation) confirming that you live at the stated address.

PROPERTY ASSESSMENT NOTICES

The 2019 Assessment Notices will be mailed out by Thursday February 7, 2019. Property Tax Notices will be mailed out in May. If you did not receive your assessment notice for the 2019 tax year by February 15, 2019 please call the Town Office and request your notice. All non-linear assessment complaints for the Town of Fairview, along with the applicable fees are due Tuesday April 16, 2019. An assessment complaint must be filled out using the Government of Alberta Assessment Review Board Complaint Form (LGS1402). This form can be provided to you by the Fairview Town Office or you can download it from the Municipal Affairs website at www.municipalaffairs.alberta.ca. Assessments are based on market value as of July 1, 2018. You may appeal the assessed value of your property, but not the tax rate. NORTH PEACE REGIONAL LANDFILL

At a recent meeting, the North Peace Regional Landfill Commission decided that a new landfill cell, #3, will be constructed during the spring/summer of 2019. Over the years the NPRL Tipping Fees have remained among the lowest compared to other communities in the Peace Country. However, in order to pay for the \$550,000 to \$600,000 construction cost, the Commission also decided to raise the Tipping Fees by 20% from \$67.40/tonne to \$80.88/tonne effective 1 March 2019. With this increase the NPRL will still be lower than industry standards.
