PROPERTY TAX NOTICES

The property tax notices will be mailed out in May 2020. If you do not receive your property tax notice by the end of May 2020, please contact the office and we will reprint it for you. Not receiving a property tax notice does NOT constitute a reason for nonpayment.

The 2020 property taxes are due June 30th, 2020 **except for the property owners on the Tax Installment Plan.**

Notice to the owners of the mobile homes in the Fairview Estates Mobile Home Park – You DO pay property tax to the Town of Fairview on your mobile home.

To assist the residents and business owners during the COVID-19 pandemic, Council of the Town of Fairview will be deferring penalties on property tax amounts levied in 2020 to October 1st, 2020. A penalty of 15% will be imposed on all property tax amounts levied in 2020 that remain unpaid after September 30, 2020. An additional penalty of 15% will be imposed of all outstanding property tax amounts that remain unpaid after December 31, 2020.
