



RE-ENTRY

Guidelines + Expectations for Resuming Pool Activities

Please do not visit if you:

- Are showing symptoms of Covid-19 such as fever, runny nose, sore throat, or shortness of breath. Please consult Alberta Health for more advice/information
- Have travelled outside of Canada within the last 14 days
- Have been in contact with anyone sick with Covid-19 within the last 14 days

The following AHS guidelines have been implemented:

- All staff and patrons are required to follow Provincial Health Guidelines
- Hand Sanitizer stations are available throughout the facility. Please utilize this when entering and exiting the facility
- Physical distancing between individuals and cohort groups must always be maintained
- Masks are not mandatory at this time, but they are strongly recommended in all indoor common areas and are provided if you forget to bring your own. No masks may be worn while swimming

Arrival and Departure

- Please follow all directional and distancing signage. All foot traffic in the facility is One Way
- Please no mingling or congregating
- Enter the reception area by the door marked Entrance Only and exit by the door marked Exit Only
- Enter the pool area through the changeroom hallway door and exit through the viewing area and out the Activity Room door

Contact Tracing

- Customers accessing the reception area only will be required to sign in
- All patrons swimming must complete a Covid-19 prescreening questionnaire. Paper copies will be available at reception at time of entry or you can pre-screen at www.fairivew.ca or www.fairviewevents.ca; click on the Covid-19 button located at the top left corner of the main screen (on-line prescreening must be completed no more than 6 hours prior to swim start time). Based on your answers you will either be allowed or denied access to the facility
- When registering for a family cohort (family members that reside in the same residence only) only one questionnaire will be required assuming all answers are the same for everyone in your cohort
- A Covid-19 prescreening assessment must be completed every time you swim
- All contact tracing records will be provided to AHS upon request

Registration

- All swimming is by pre-registration only, this will enable control of attendance numbers as per new guidelines
- You must book your spot the day before the swim
- To register call pool reception 780-835-2812 ext. 3
- All bookings are on a first come, first serve basis
- No transfers or refunds
- First swim day is Wednesday, October 14, reception will open on Tuesday, October 13 from 9:30am-4:30pm to take registrations
- Punch cards and memberships will be checked in upon arrival. Cash and Debit accepted, however paying with a credit card over the phone at time of booking to reserve your spot is preferred.
