



RE-ENTRY

Guidelines + Expectations for Resuming Pool Activities

Swimming Lessons

- All swimming lessons are by pre-registration only
- Payment must be received at the time of registration to book your spot
- Due to Covid-19 Red Cross requires Preschool (age 3-5yr) & Level 1/2/3 (age 5-7yr) participants to have a responsible adult age 18+ in the water with the child during the lesson
- A Covid-19 prescreening assessment is required for both the participant and the adult. If they both reside in the same residence only one form is required if the answers for both are all the same
- A Covid-19 prescreening assessment is required for every lesson attended
- Registration for lessons opens Tuesday, October 13 at 9:30am.

Additional swim lesson info

- Swimmers who arrive for lessons without an adult to accompany them in the water will not be allowed to participate
- Participants in swim lessons who do not live in the same household must maintain 2m physical distancing in the water
- Instructors are required to remain on the deck wearing a face shield unless doing a quick in-water demonstration
- Registration for fall swim lessons opens Tuesday, October 13 at 9:30am. www.fairview.ca for details
- No spectators allowed in the viewing area

Sign-in Process

- Please arrive no more than 20 minutes prior to your reserved swim time
- Covid-19 pre-screening and payment upon arrival. Present emailed QR Code for scanning or paper copies available
- Swimmers will be permitted to enter change rooms 5-10 minutes prior to booked swim time/lesson

Entering to Swim

- Only 4 patrons allowed in the change rooms at one time on entry, so it is recommended that you come dressed to swim to limit the time spent in change room and to allow timely admittance for all swimmers
- Covid-19 responsible staff will monitor change room entries
- Lockers are Not Available currently. Please do not bring any valuables. Swimmers will be provided with a plastic tub to hold their belongings and these will be carried onto the pool deck and placed in the designated area
- Showers are available upon entry. Please take a cleansing shower before swimming
- Handicap or Special Needs patrons may request the Family change room for entry and exit
- Physical distancing must always be maintained between individuals and cohort groups

Equipment

- Blow Dryers prohibited
- Pool toys, rope swing, climbing wall, skywalker, diving board are not available
- You may bring your own clean pool toys, please shower them off with the deck shower before entering pool
- No sharing of toys outside your family cohort
- No sharing goggles
- Lifejackets and baby boats are available and will be cleaned after each use
