RE-ENTRY

Guidelines + Expectations for Resuming Pool Activities

During your Swim

- Physical distancing must be maintained between all individuals and cohort groups
- Water fountain is closed. Please bring your own filled water bottle or ask the lifeguard for a drink
- Washroom open in the family change room
- No spectators allowed in the viewing area

After your Swim

- COVID responsible staff will escort patrons into sanitized men's & women's change rooms to quickly dry and redress, 4 patrons at a time
- The public washroom in the activity room hallway will be open as a change room and if the Family change room has not been reserved for Handicap or Special Needs patrons, it may also be used for changing
- Only the shower on the deck is available for a quick rinse off, no showers available in change rooms.
- Exit is through the viewing area and out through the Exit Only door at reception
- Please do not linger or congregate as you exit

Program Numbers

- Fit & 50+ and Evening Aqua Size maximum 20 participants
- Lanes - 1 per lane or Family Cohort of up to 3 patrons
- Family/Adult Swim - maximum 30 patrons
- Family/Adult Swim with Lanes - maximum 30 patrons

Private Rentals

- Maximum 30 people
- Physical distancing must be maintained between individuals not residing in the same home and between cohort groups
- No toys available, you may bring your own clean toys
- Activity Room is not available for bookings

Facility Hours

- Pool closed Monday and Tuesday and Stat holidays
- Please see www.fairview.ca for weekly pool & reception hours
- Facility doors will be locked if receptionist is away from the counter

Parking

Please be advised that GPRC has implemented paid parking on campus. Free parking for pool patrons is only available in the parking lot located outside the pool main entry doors and is clearly marked as Fairview Aquatic staff and patrons parking only. Once this parking lot is full it is your responsibility to access GPRC paid parking as per instructions on signage located in each parking lot.
