RESIDENTIAL SIDEWALK CLEANING

Fairview Town Council's vision of providing a quality, sustainable, engaged and attractive community, now includes the Residential Sidewalk Clearing Program. This snow removal program will run as a trial for the 2020-2021 winter season, and as Public Works crew begin working with the new machinery we ask the public to remain patient as we process the best possible work plan for our community. Crews will begin testing the new equipment shortly and throughout this trial season they will be providing snow removal for all sidewalks in residential areas of Fairview. With this new Council initiative, there will be NO Bylaw Enforcement of residential sidewalk clearing; however as this is the trial season we are not able to anticipate the time duration for sidewalk clearing. We welcome you to continue clearing your residential area if you are not satisfied waiting for Public Works to clear in your area.
