

Council Highlights

June 3, 2025

Aquatic Centre HVAC Replacement: Council awarded the Aquatic Centre HVAC project to Reynolds' Plumbing and Heating for \$530,000. The work will begin in late October or early November, and the new rooftop units are expected to improve energy efficiency and reduce operational costs.

Regional Partnership Efforts: On June 24, Town Council representatives will meet with Clear Hills County Council to request support for the HVAC replacement project.

Upcoming Community Events:

- **SOS (Start of Summer) Festival & Lemonade Days:** Mark your calendars for June 14. This year's SOS Festival will be held at the NWP campus grounds.
- Fairview Rodeo Parade: Happening July 19 at 11:00 a.m. Come out and enjoy the festivities!

Community Services Update: Reports show increased attendance at both the Aquatic Centre and the Fitness Centre — great news for our recreational facilities!

RCMP Report: Cpl. Kurt Fink shared that crime continues to trend downward. He extended thanks to the community for reporting suspicious activity directly to the RCMP. Planning is also underway for the RCMP Musical Ride, scheduled for August 26 at the Waterhole Rodeo Grounds. Expect an exciting preshow featuring dogs and drones.

Strategic Planning: Council continues to work on the development of a new Strategic Plan, with adoption targeted prior to the October municipal election.

Road Work Reminder: Construction has begun on the 102 Ave/103 Ave project. Watch for detours and temporary closures in the area.

Capital Plan Adjustment: The Treated Water Reservoir Project (estimated at \$1.8 million) will be moved from 2027 to 2026 to meet provincial grant conditions. Administration will update the 5-year Capital Plan accordingly for Council's review.

Summer Meeting Schedule: Council meetings scheduled for July 1 and August 5 have been cancelled as part of the summer recess.
