

Council Highlights

July 15, 2025

Summer Council Meeting Schedule: Council meetings scheduled for **July 1 and August 5** have been cancelled as part of the summer schedule.

PRAMP Delegation & Membership: The Peace River Area Monitoring Program (PRAMP) provided updates on their air quality monitoring efforts. They are installing a new air monitoring device at STM School to provide localized air quality data. Council has agreed to join PRAMP as a no-cost member.

102 Ave / 103 Ave Construction: The road project continues, construction begins on 103 Ave next week.

Aquatic Centre Upgrade Support: Clear Hills County will contribute \$30,000 toward the \$580,000 Aquatic Centre upgrade project, which includes new rooftop HVAC units and improved lighting.

Recreation Rates Update: Recreation facility rates will increase by 2% in September.

Pioneer Museum Update: The Fairview Agricultural Society shared that the Pioneer Museum group may be stepping down this fall.

Old RCMP Museum Building: The old RCMP museum building, unused for several years, will have its utilities shut off. The Town will explore future options for the site.

Strategic Plan Development: Council continues working on a new strategic plan, aiming to have it adopted before the October municipal election.

Patio Series Returns: The Patio Series is back and taking place every Wednesday this summer.

Rodeo Parade – July 19: The Waterhole Rodeo is July 18–20, with the parade on July 19 at 11:00 am.

Summer's End Festival – August 23: This year's festival will shift locations due to construction. The event will run from the **Legion to the Curling Rink**, including surrounding roads and the Arena area.

Fairview's Centennial – 2028: Did you know? The **Town of Fairview turns 100 in 2028!** Stay tuned for future celebration planning.
